Create a story using as many of the Seven Steps as you can.

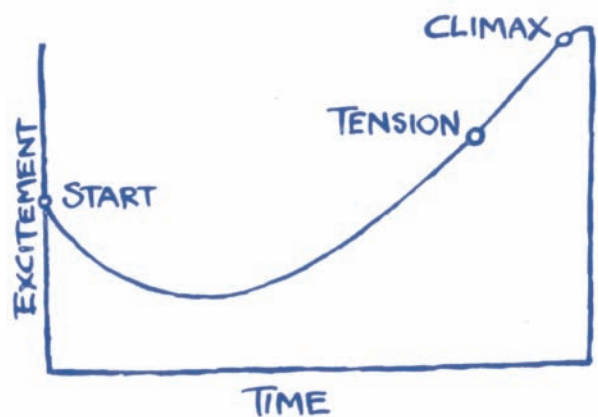
The hardest part is planning a story, so we'll work on that first BEFORE you start writing.
